WHEREAS, the Route 4 "Greenbelt" was created approximately in 1933 to create a favorable impression upon anyone entering Teaneck by the Route 4 state highway; and

WHEREAS, this area, consisting of strips along the highway which are at the level of the highway and have been planted with shrubbery and flowers; and

WHEREAS, this "greenbelt" serves as a buffer to prevent imposition into the adjacent residential areas; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation is conducting a corridor study on Route 4 with the intention of widening the existing three lanes with an adjoining shoulder, thereby altering the greenbelt; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council would like to maintain this greenbelt in its present form and has decided to apply for dedication of the greenbelt as a historical landmark,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Teaneck, that authorization is hereby given for submission of application forms to the New Jersey and National Registers of Historical Places.
